Purpose: The Good Shepherd Animal Sanctuary is a public non-profit charity in accordance with federal 501(c)(3) guidelines. The organization’s goal is to improve the lives of all sentient creatures. Founded in 2018, The Good Shepherd Animal Sanctuary (TGSAS) has rescued animals at risk of abuse, neglect, and slaughter.

When: May to October of 2023, exact date and timing expectations will be discussed to suit the applicant.

Unpaid Internship: This is an unpaid position that does not compensate for your time. Gas stipend shall be discussed with any applicant seeking to fulfill hour requirements for a university, training, or schooling need. A minimum of two (2) four hour (4 Hr) shifts per week is required.

Description: Interns will learn skills necessary for managing and caring for a wide spectrum of species in a Sanctuary environment. Interns will work in all weather conditions and are considered essential workers. Interns will learn care and proper procedures to address the needs of 78 residents including but not limited to: Cows, Goats, Sheep, Horses, Donkeys, Mules, Pigs, Chickens, Ducks, Rabbits, Turkeys, Cats, and Dogs. This position is not limited to the below description:

At-Will Employment: Your internship with the Sanctuary is a volunteer, at-will position. The Sanctuary reserves the right to terminate your intern relationship at any time, with or without cause or advance notice. The Sanctuary will determine compensation/intern benefits on a situational case-by-case basis depending on applicant's needs.

Additional Agreements: Additional agreements or disclosures may be necessary and may be required prior to the start of your internship. This includes but is not limited to: agreements that relate to your confidentiality, intellectual property, assignment obligations to the Sanctuary, or other documents/agreements the Sanctuary or its Board of Directors feel is necessary to satisfy the applicant and Sanctuary's needs.

Background or Reference Checks may be requested or may be completed by the Sanctuary prior to any acceptance or on-boarding process that is needed.

Additional Terms and Conditions of Internship: The Good Shepherd Animal Sanctuary is requiring all intern applicants to be 18 years of age or older. The organization is Vegan founded with Vegan Values and will NOT permit animal products for human consumption or human benefit on the premises.

Application for Service: In order to apply for internship, applicants must submit a **resume**, **two letters of recommendation**, and a **letter of application** explaining why the applicant would like to work with The Good Shepherd Animal Sanctuary. Applicants are encouraged to familiarize themselves with The Good Shepherd Animal Sanctuary's mission, core values, and philosophies through exploring the website. Application requirements are subject to change or modification at the discretion of The Sanctuary and the Sanctuary's Board of Directors.
